



FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR RYCO CABIN FILTER RCA318P

NISSAN Patrol (Y61), Pathfinder (R50 Series II)

1. Both cabin air filters are located behind the glovebox. The complet	е
assembly is required to be removed to change the filters.	

- 2. Remove all the screws holding the compartment in place. With the unit closed start removing the bottom screws, then open the unit and remove all other screws.
- 3. With all screws removed pull the entire unit out carefully and disconnect any electrical connections.
- 4. The cabin air filters are designed to act as the lid, they are secured by a clip attached to the bottom filter. Slide out the clip and pull the bottom filter out and then proceed to remove the remaining filter carefully to prevent any accumulated debris from being spread around.
- 5. Clean the area well and insert the new cabin air filters in the right air flow direction as indicated on filter and refit all components in the reverse order.
