## FILTER IS LOCATION BEHIND THE GLOVE BOX



## STEP 1

The cabin filter is located behind the glove box. To gain access to the cabin filter follow the instructions explained on this sheet.



#### STEP 4

Open the glove box and release the stoppers by pushing inwards on the rear top of the box as indicated in the picture.



## STEP 2

Lean the glove box on your knee Aand proceed to unhinge the strut by gently pulling in the direction shown on the picture.



**STEP 3** Push clips in the direction shown and remove the cabin air filter housing lid.



#### STEP 5

The glove box can now be removed and the cabin filter housing will be easily identifiable. Pull the lid cover upwards to gain acces to main housing lid.



## STEP 6

Remove old filter and replace with new Ryco filter making sure it is on the right air flow direction and refit all components in reverse order.






# **TOYOTA TARAGO**

## FILTER IS LOCATION BEHIND THE GLOVE BOX




#### STEP 1

The cabin air filter is located behind the glove compartment.




## STEP 2

Open the glove compartment and remove the support arm by sliding arm of the pin.




## STEP 3

Apply pressure to the front and rear of glove compartment as shown to disengage the claws, open all the way.




## **STEP 4** To remove filter assembly, push on both ends of the cover as shown and pull out.



#### STEP 5

Noting flow direction remove old filter, insert new filter (Note flow direction) then refit all previously removed parts.



**STEP 6** Dispose of used filter correctly.
