




FILTER IS LOCATED BEHIND THE GLOVE BOX




STEP 1
The cabin air filter is located behind the glove compartment.




Open the glove compartment & remove the support arm by sliding the arm off the pin (A) or removing the Phillips head screw (B) (if either are fitted).




Push each side of glove compartment (A & B) to release catches then remove glove compartment.



STEP 4
To remove filter assembly, hold tray on both sides as shown and pull out.



Remove used filter from tray, fit new filter to tray, making sure that flat side is facing down.




Push new filter assembly and tray into position then refit all previously removed components. Dispose of used filter correctly.




FILTER IS LOCATED BEHIND THE GLOVE BOX




STEP 1Open glove box, apply pressure to both sides of glove box to release catches.



Remove used filter from tray. Fit new Ryco filter, refit all previously removed components.



STEP 2Open glove box as far as possible and remove.




STEP 4 Dispose of used filter correctly.




FILTER IS LOCATED BEHIND THE GLOVE BOX




STEP 1The cabin air filter is located behind the glove compartment.




STEP 2
Open the glove compartment and remove the screw on the support arm with a Phillips head screwdriver.




Push each side of glove compartment (A & B) to release catches then remove glove compartment.



STEP 4To remove filter assembly, hold tray on both sides as shown and pull out.



Remove used filter from tray, fit new filter to tray, making sure that flat side is facing down.



Push new filter assembly and tray into position then refit all previously removed components. Dispose of used filter correctly.
